Fire Station, Cambridge for Peterborough & Cambridgeshire Fire Authority

Construction of a temporary fire station to re-house an operational unit to make way for a major mixed used redevelopment in the centre of Cambridge.

This design & build project was secured via a competitive tender process on the basis of an economical and totally re-usable accommodation design solution. The project included portal frame structures to house 4 fire tenders plus 'portacabin' type control, administration, messing and welfare facilities for a fully operational fire service.

All the structures were designed to be disassembled on completion and re-used elsewhere by the Fire Authority.
