> The steelwork and pre-fabricated sections of the extension were craned into position, with deliveries and activities phased around daily routine of the school. whilst minimising the construction traffic effect on neighbours.

We were able to undertake all works without disturbing the academy's activities and even accommodated some quiet days during exam sittings.

> The academy campus was occupied throughout the construction programme and our success was based upon cooperative approach and regular liaison with the school's Building Manager and our site team.
